

Campbell, Los Gatos, Monte Sereno, Saratoga:

Set out at curb on your collection day (do not put in yard waste cart or container), during the weeks of Dec. 26 - Jan. 12. Cut trees in half if over 6 feet. Multi-Family residents place trees near garbage bin. If collection after Jan. 12, cut up and bundle tree or cut up to fit in the yard waste container. Flocked trees accepted. Call (408) 354-2100.

Cupertino, Los Altos, Unincorporated Los Altos Hills:

Collection during the month of January. Place trees curbside/roadside on regular yard waste collection day. Cut trees in 4-foot lengths. Small trees can also be placed in yard waste carts for collection. Apartment & condo - Pickup from central location. Mgr. should call when ready for pickup. Call Los Altos Garbage Company at (650) 961-8040 or (408) 725-4020. Flocked trees are acceptable.

Gilroy:

Curbside pickup on weekly yard trimming collection days. Cut trees in 3 feet sections. No charge to drop off trees at San Martin Transfer Station, 14070 Llagas Ave., San Martin, through Jan. 31. Flocked trees are accepted for recycling. If you are a resident of the unincorporated area of Santa Clara County please set your holiday trees out on your garbage collection day between Dec. 26 and Jan. 11. Call South Valley Disposal & Recycling at (408) 842-3358.

Morgan Hill:

Curbside pickup on weekly yard trimming collection days. Cut trees in 3 feet sections. No charge to drop off trees at San Martin Transfer Station, 14070 Llagas Ave., San Martin, through Jan. 31. Flocked trees are accepted for recycling. If you are a resident of the unincorporated area of Santa Clara County please set your holiday trees out on your garbage collection day between Dec. 26 and Jan. 11. Call South Valley Disposal & Recycling at (408) 842-3358.

Milpitas:

Holiday tree curbside pick-up occurs on collection days from Dec. 29 - Jan. 9. Cut trees in 4-foot lengths. Apartment residents: call for tree collection information (unless complex has curbside cart service, then put cut trees next to carts). For details please call Allied Waste Services at (408) 432-0444.

Mountain View:

Curbside pickup of flocked and green trees on recycling day between Dec. 26 - Jan. 23 at no charge. Trees over 5 feet should be cut in half. Apt. Mgrs. may arrange for service by calling Foothill Disposal at (650) 967-3034. After January 19, put cut up trees in yard waste cart or purchase and attach an extra garbage tag to tree.

Holiday Tree Recycling



Trees with decorations, tinsel, stands and/or nails CANNOT be recycled.

Palo Alto:

Separate tree from stand, remove all ornaments and tinsel, cut in 4-ft. lengths, and set out on pick-up day with other recyclables. Apartment and condominium residents, contact your Property Mgr. for scheduled curbside collection dates. Free drop-off at landfill available Dec. 26 - Jan. 31. Flocked trees cannot be

recycled. Call the Zero Waste Program at (650) 496-5910 for more information.

San Jose:

Cut trees in 5-foot lengths and set out at curb by 6 am on your collection day. Flocked trees will be accepted for composting without an Extra Garbage Sticker. Apt. residents should contact Property Mgr. for collection details. Recycle your holiday tree from Dec. 26 to Feb. 1. For more information about tree recycling, or holiday collection schedule, please call (408) 535-3500.

Santa Clara:

Curbside pickup on regular single-family waste collection day Jan. 9 - 13 (multi-family residents call (408) 615-3080 to find out what the collection day is); thereafter, cut tree into 3-foot lengths, place in Clean Green cart and set out on regular collection day. Drop off at Monroe and San Tomas Expressway, Jan. 5 - 9, from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm only. Flocked trees accepted. (408) 615-3080.

Sunnyvale:

Curbside pickup for single family, duplex, triplex and mobile homes on collection day. Cut trees in 4-foot or shorter lengths and place in or beside yard trimmings cart at curbside. Flocked and painted trees are acceptable. Apartment residents, contact your manager for tree recycling options. City of Sunnyvale Recycling, (408) 730-7262.

Stanford:

PSSI will collect holiday trees for recycling on your scheduled yard waste collection day. Cut trees taller than 4 feet into sections. Place your tree at the curb, not in your yard waste cart. Flocked trees cannot be recycled. (650) 321-4236.
