- **3 compact fluorescent light (CFL) bulbs** — use 75% less energy than old-fashioned bulbs!
- **1 retractable clothesline** — save \$85/year by drying clothes for free!
- **1 low-flow showerhead and 3 faucet aerators** — conserve local water supplies and reduce heating costs too!
- **Adjustments to your water heater and refrigerator temperatures** — get those settings "just right" and save even more.
- **Suggestions to reduce phantom power usage** — reduce wasted energy and money.

We'll also recommend next steps to further your savings in the future!
